Course: HS Boys & Girls – 5000 Meters; JH Boys & Girls – 1.5 Miles; The course is relatively flat with a few small hills on the North side of the course. Runners will begin on the west side of fairgrounds buildings. Please see the included maps.

Facilities: Restrooms are available next to the open air pavilion.

Parking: Please use the south entrance off of 144th St for parking.

Teams: Conestoga, Elmwood-Murdock, Pawnee City, Syracuse, and Weeping Water

Packets: Packets will be located at the finish line tent in the middle of the fairgrounds for your school. Numbers will be assigned by Black Squirrel Timing. They are to be placed on the front of the runner. Please take any scratches or changes to the Black Squirrel Timing tent. Safety pins will be available in your packets.

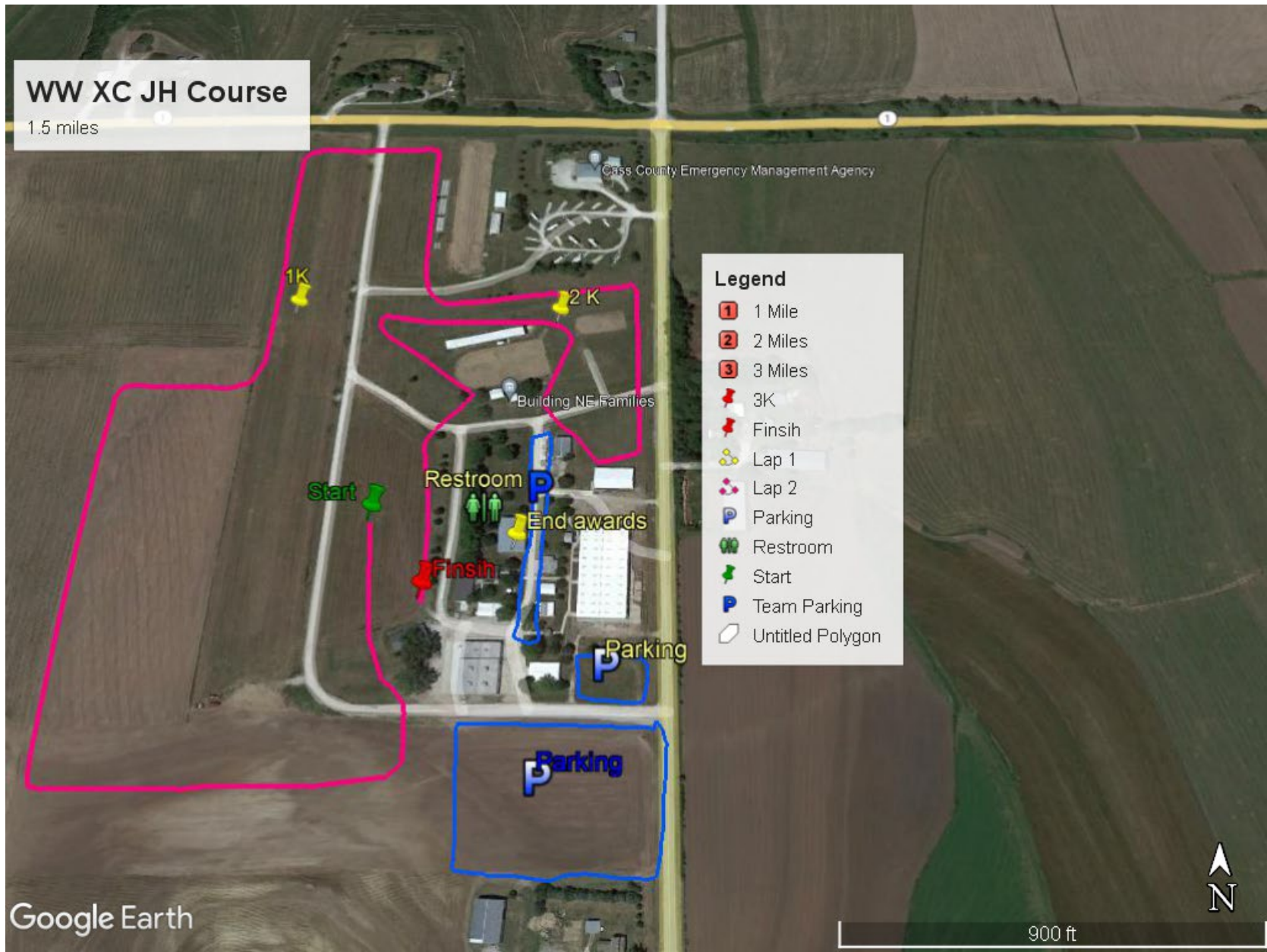
